# Global Annual Conference 2025 at the QEII Centre, London

The conference brought together an exceptional line-up of speakers — including the **Prime Minister, Keir Starmer**; the **Leader of the Opposition, Kemi Badenoch**; and the **Governor of the Bank of England, Andrew Bailey**, amongst many others — all sharing compelling visions for driving UK economic growth.

**BCC's Chair, Sarah Howard MBE,** talked about the power of the Chamber network - "From grassroots to government" - and the insights shared by delegates.

One golden thread has run through all the conversations: "Growth in the UK will only be achieved if we embrace innovation, invest in people, and empower local leadership".

During the conference, the **Prime Minister, Keir Starmer**, officially **unveiled the UK Trade Strategy**, outlining the government's vision to boost international trade, support British businesses, and position the UK as a leading global trading nation. The strategy incorporates several important components, including:



# **London Tech Week (Olympia, London)**



The **British Hellenic Chamber of Commerce (BHCC)** participated in **London Tech Week**, with a Greek delegation of start-ups and venture capital funds in collaboration with the **British Embassy in Athens**.

**BHCC** continues to play a vital role in fostering closer ties between the **Greek and UK Tech ecosystems**, actively promoting collaboration and innovation across borders.

In a surprise appearance, **UK Prime Minister, Keir Starmer**, delivered the opening speech at **London Tech Week**, offering an inspiring vision for the future.

Inspiring speeches on the future of AI were delivered by industry leaders including **Jensen Huang**, CEO of NVIDIA; **Tanuja Randery**, Vice President and Managing Director for Europe, Middle East, and Africa at Amazon Web Services; **Emeka Emembolu**, Executive Vice President of Technology at BP; and **Cindy Hoots**, Chief Digital Officer & CIO of AstraZeneca.

The conference also featured a compelling panel discussion titled "Why the UK is the Ultimate Launchpad to Expand Your Business," moderated by Baroness Poppy Gustafsson CBE, Minister for Investment (UK Government). Panelists shared strategic insights into the UK's role as a global tech and innovation hub. Furthermore, Peter Kyle, MP, Secretary of State for Science, Innovation and Technology, UK, outlined the government's vision for shaping the digital landscape. His message was one of optimism, but also a call for bold risk-taking to achieve meaningful results. He spoke of ambitions for a future that is "bright, bold, and risky."

London Tech Week is a global gathering of tech leaders shaping not only the future of AI but also how we innovate and collaborate in this new era. The participation of leading tech companies—including Microsoft, Amazon Web Services, Google Cloud, and NVIDIA—underscores the UK's role as a hub for AI innovation.

One of the most inspiring moments of the day was hearing from **Sir Tim Berners-Lee**, **inventor of the World Wide Web.** In his talk on "Agentic Wallets: The Key to Reclaiming a Web That Works for Everyone," he explored the internet's current shortcomings and emphasized why restoring user control over personal data is critical for rebuilding trust and sparking innovation.

**David Schwimmer, CEO of the London Stock Exchange Group,** discussed the UK's strengths as a global capital market and how AI and data are fueling global economic growth.


